**Associate's degree in paralegal studies with 60 semester credit hours or equivalent, including a minimum of 24 semester credit hours or equivalent of paralegal specialty courses;**

***OR***

**Associate's degree in any subject (60 semester credit hours or equivalent) PLUS minimum of 24 semester credit hours or equivalent of paralegal specialty courses;**

***OR***

**Bachelor's degree in paralegal studies, including 24 semester hours or equivalent of paralegal specialty courses;**

***OR***

**Bachelor's degree in any subject plus 24 semester credit hours or equivalent of paralegal specialty courses.**

- \* If any applicant has been working as a paralegal for five years or more he/she is “grandfathered” from the above-referenced requirements.**
